POSITION SUMMARY:

This position supports the work of the Y, a leading nonprofit, charitable organization committed to strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility. Under the direction and supervision of the Early Childhood Director, the Pre-K Lead teacher will supervise and guide a child's development in a safe and healthy environment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Must have strong group control working with a group of 15-25 children.
- Able to work 2pm-6pm, Monday-Friday and full days when school is out.
- Prepare, set up and implement daily activities based on the provided curriculum.
- Able to perform indoor and outdoor activities.
- Ability to walk, stand and sit (including on the floor) for long periods of time.
- Adheres to Licensing and program standards including safety and cleanliness.
- Supervises and engages with children during all activities.
- Maintains space and all supplies and equipment.
- Maintains thorough knowledge of Licensing Standards and maintains compliance at all times.
- Able to lead and implement chants, songs, cheers, attention grabbers throughout the day.
- Able to supervise children and provide for their safety throughout the day including while in the pool, on the playground, and on field trips.
- Completion of all required training prior to start date and throughout the summer/school year.
- First Aid/CPR certification required within 30 days.

- Must possess oral, auditory and written communication skills.
- Must be able to take initiative, have strong time management skills and be able to work independently if necessary.
- Must maintain a current CPR/First Aid Certification (Training can be provided).
- Must complete and pass a background check.

Pre-K Lead Teachers : Must be at least 18 years old or older.
